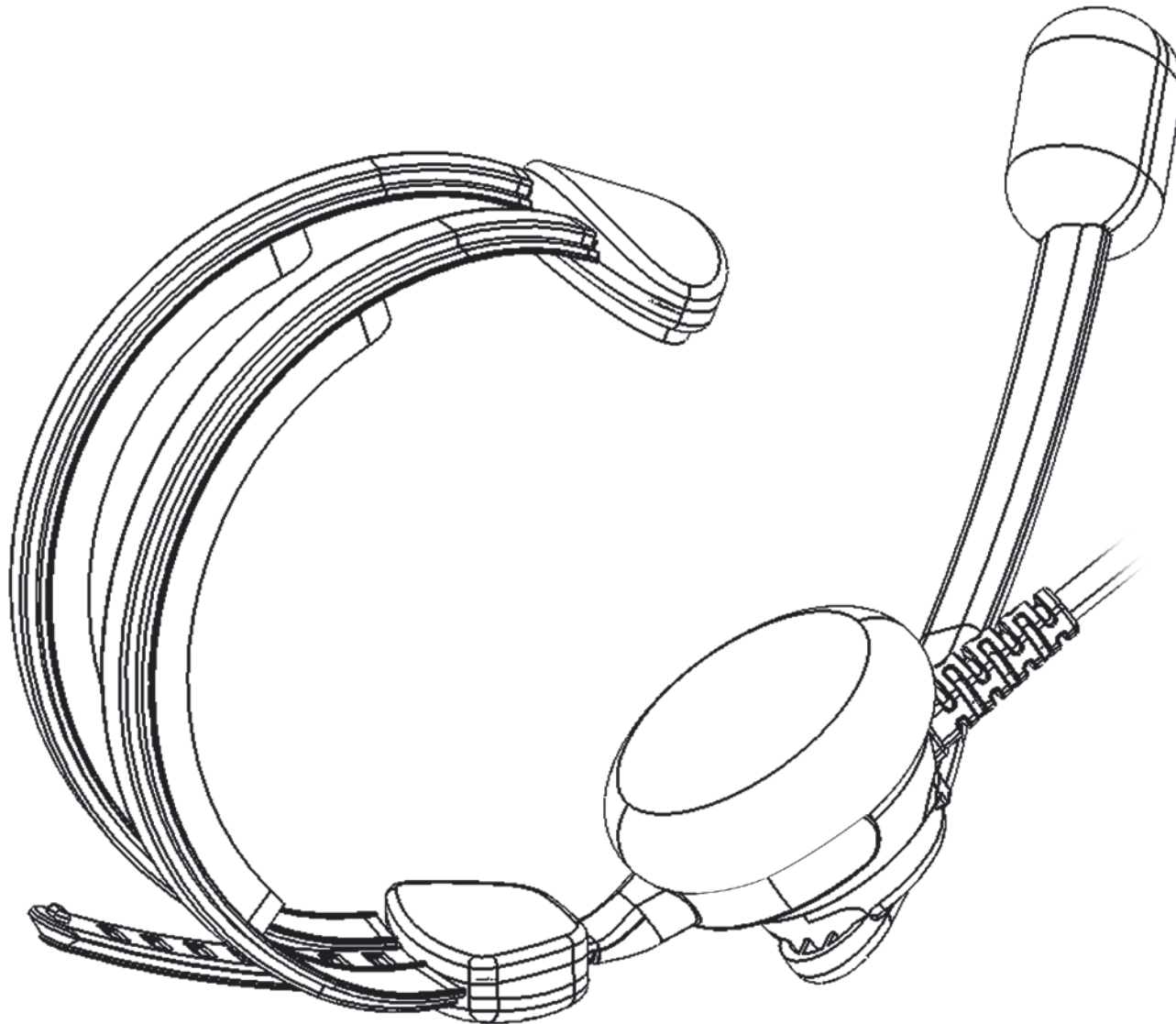

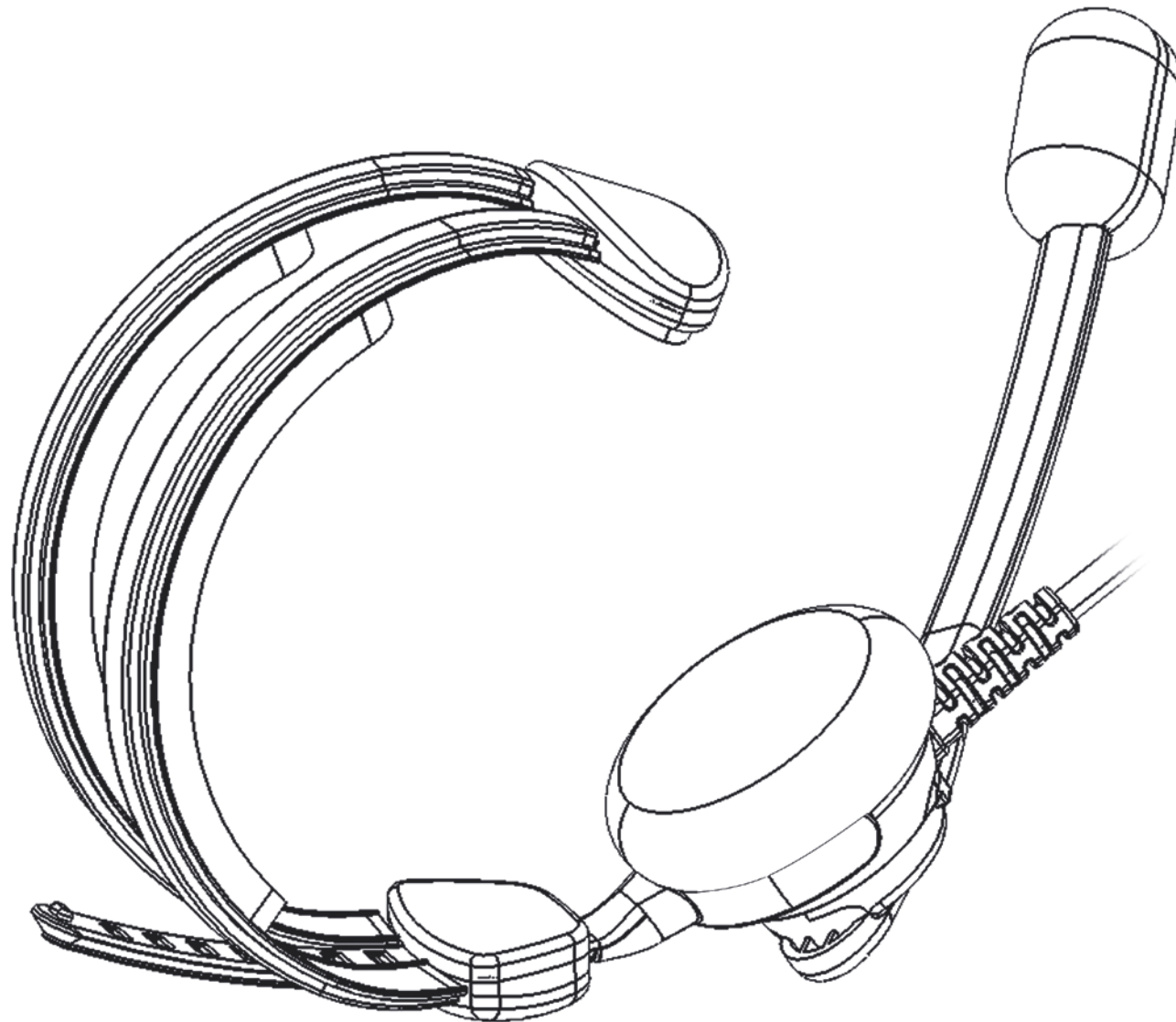

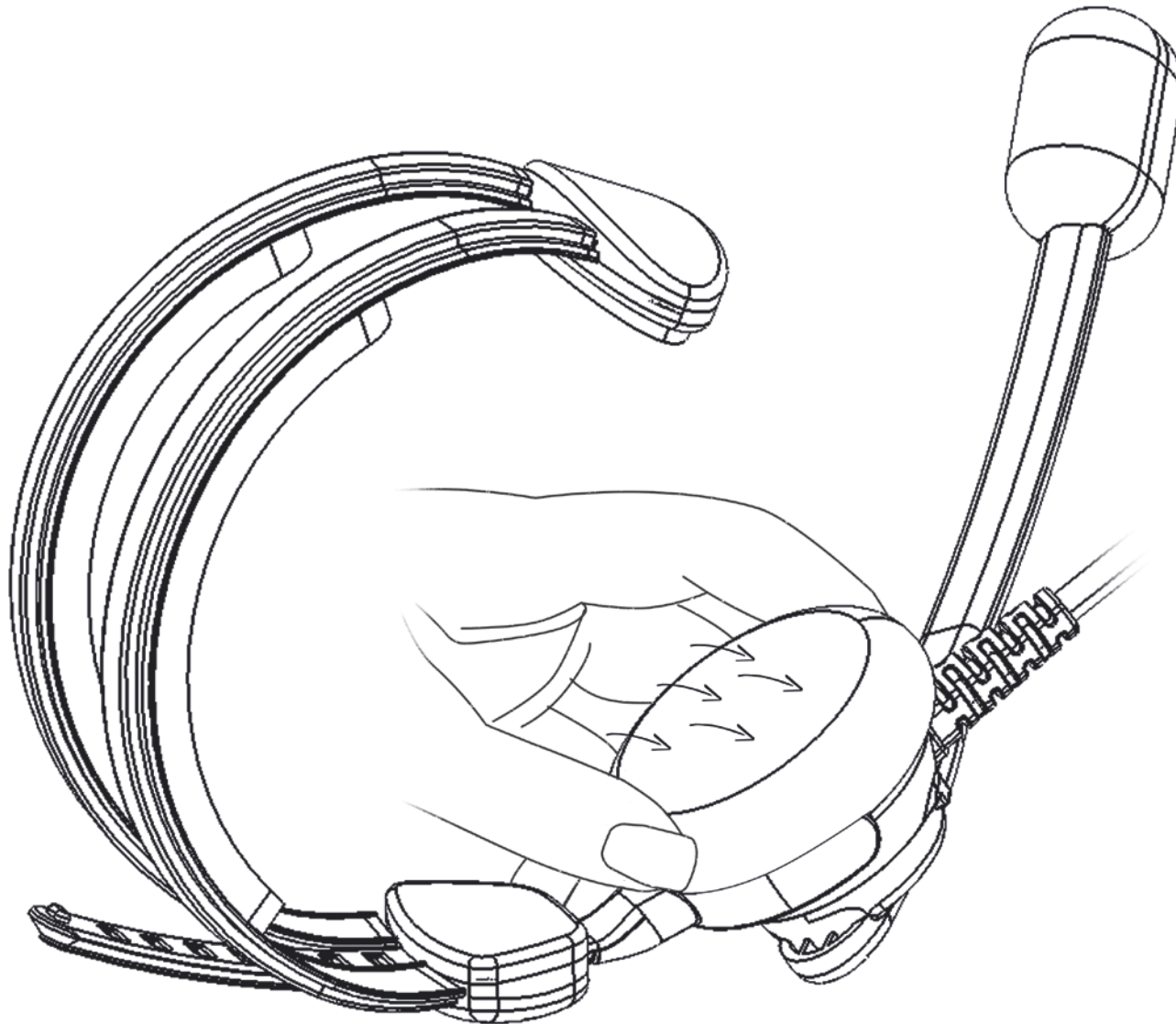
Put the headset in front of you





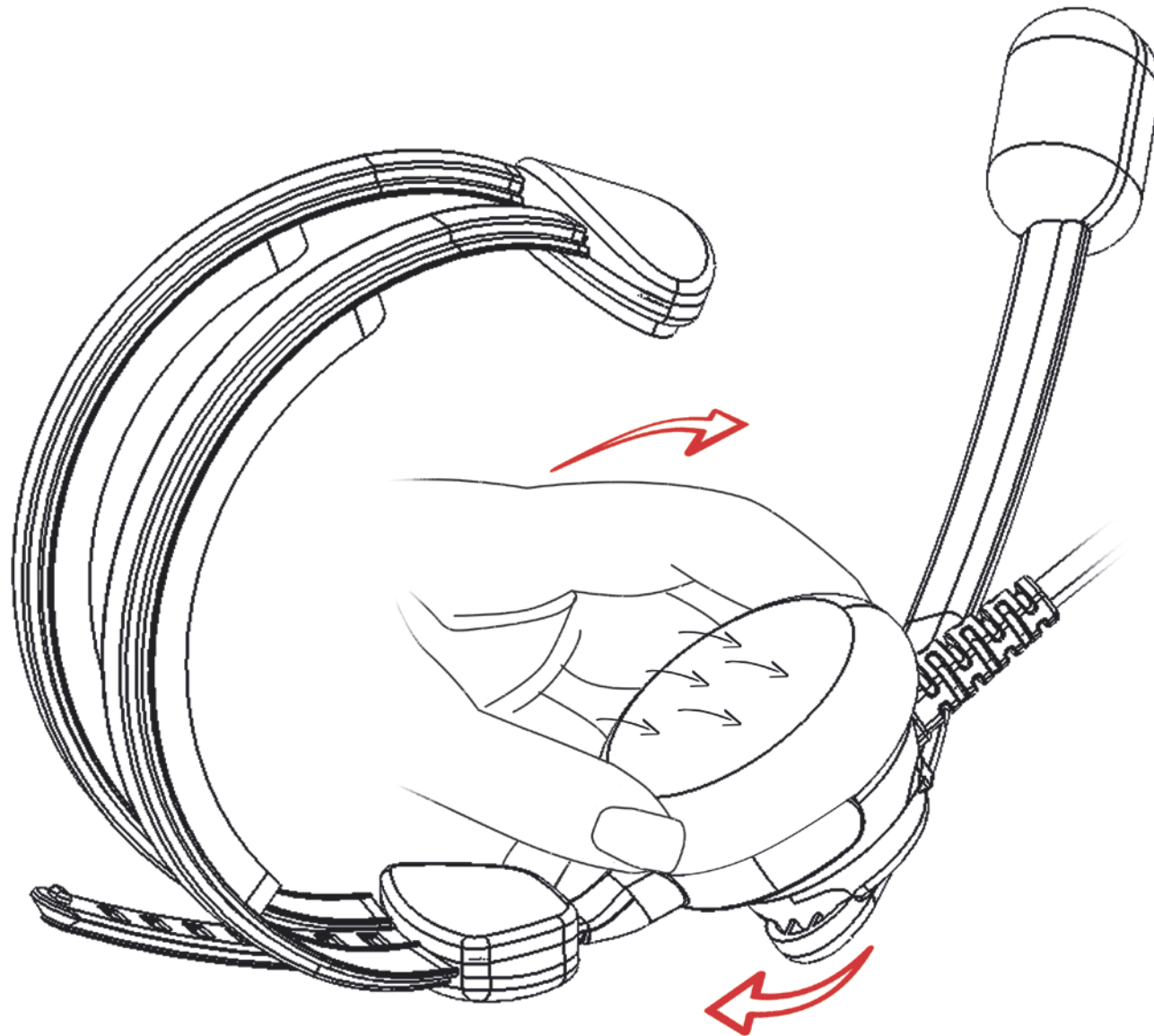
Get grip of the mounting disk through the ear-pad





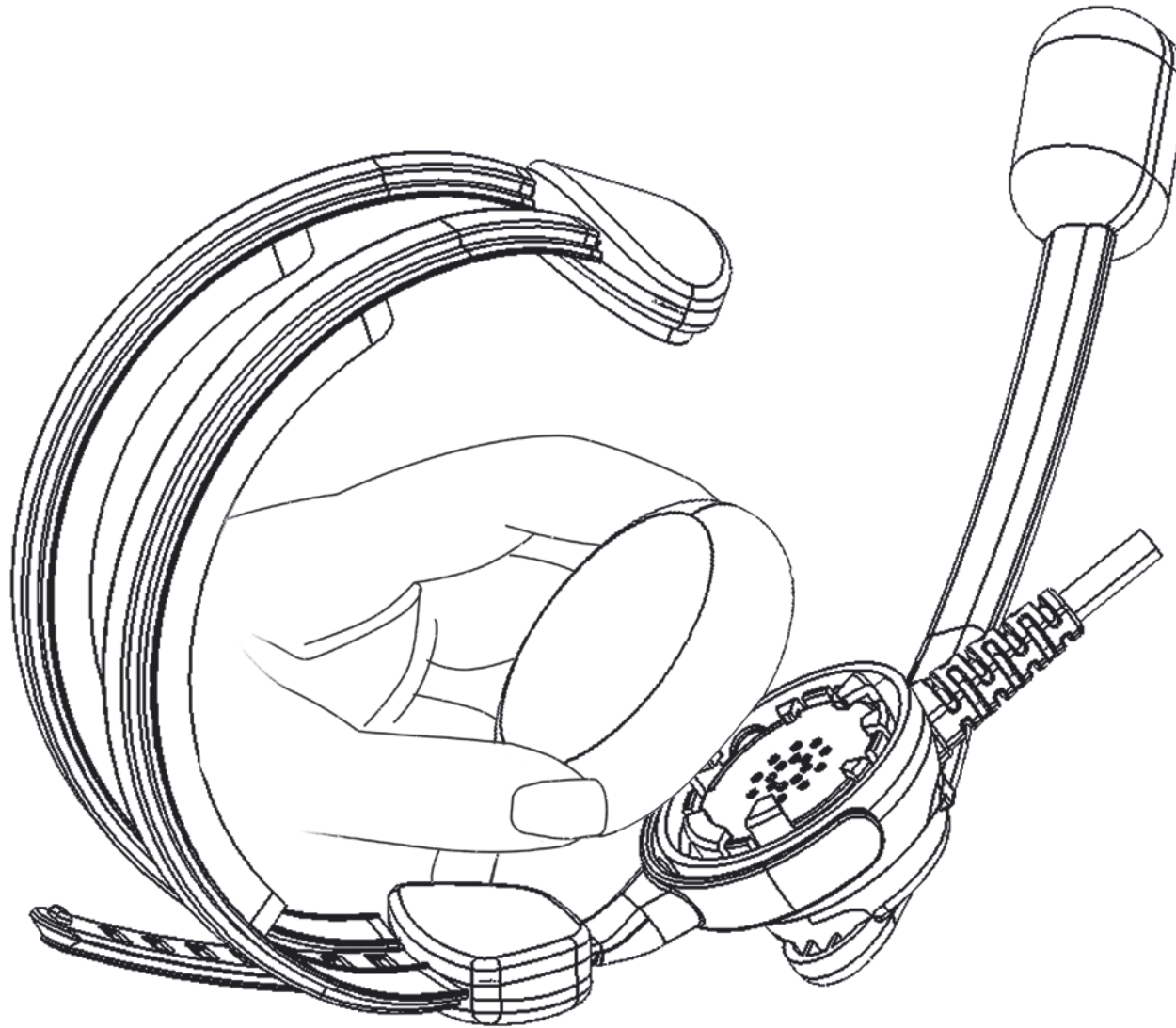
Slightly push...





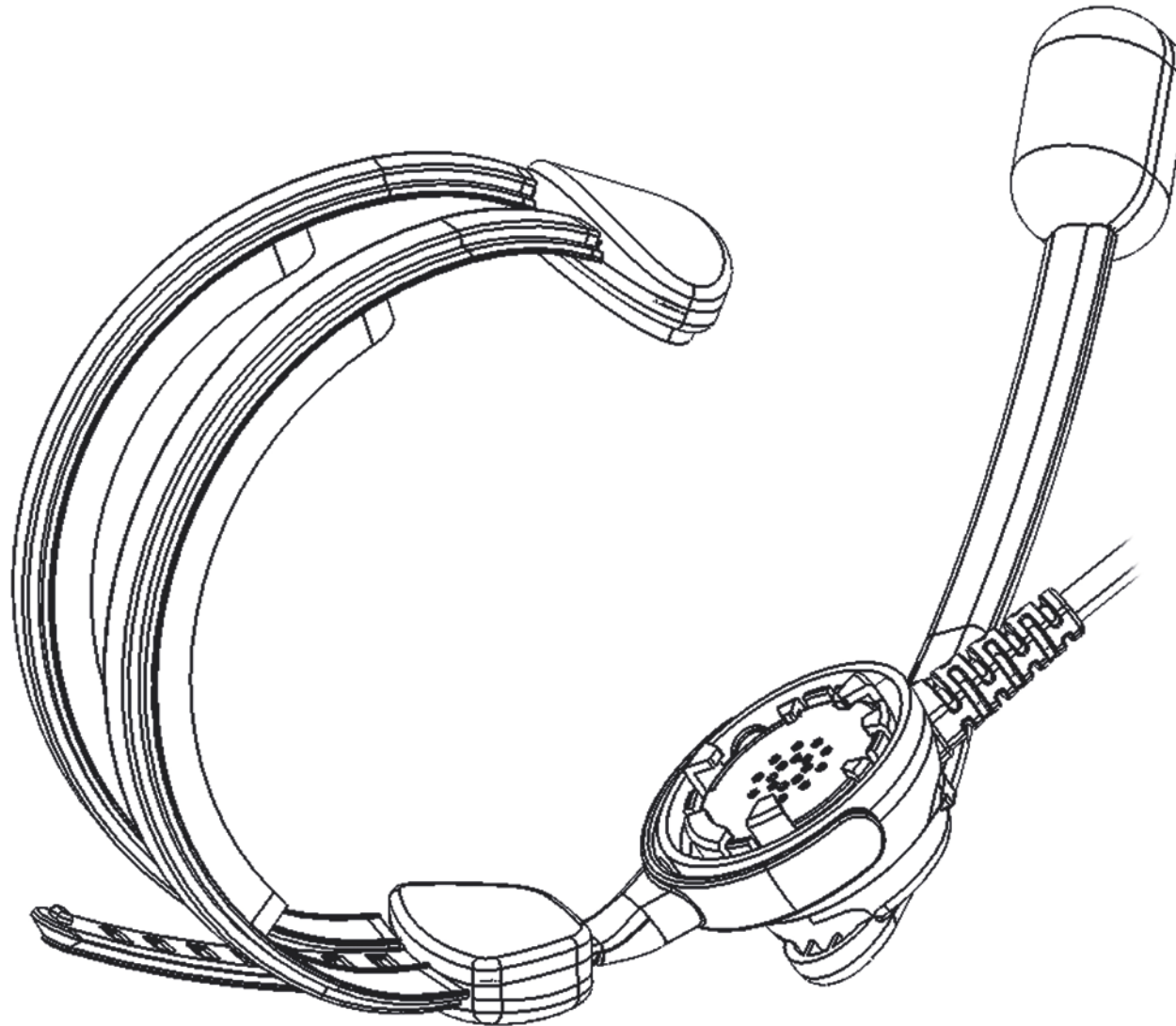
...and rotate...





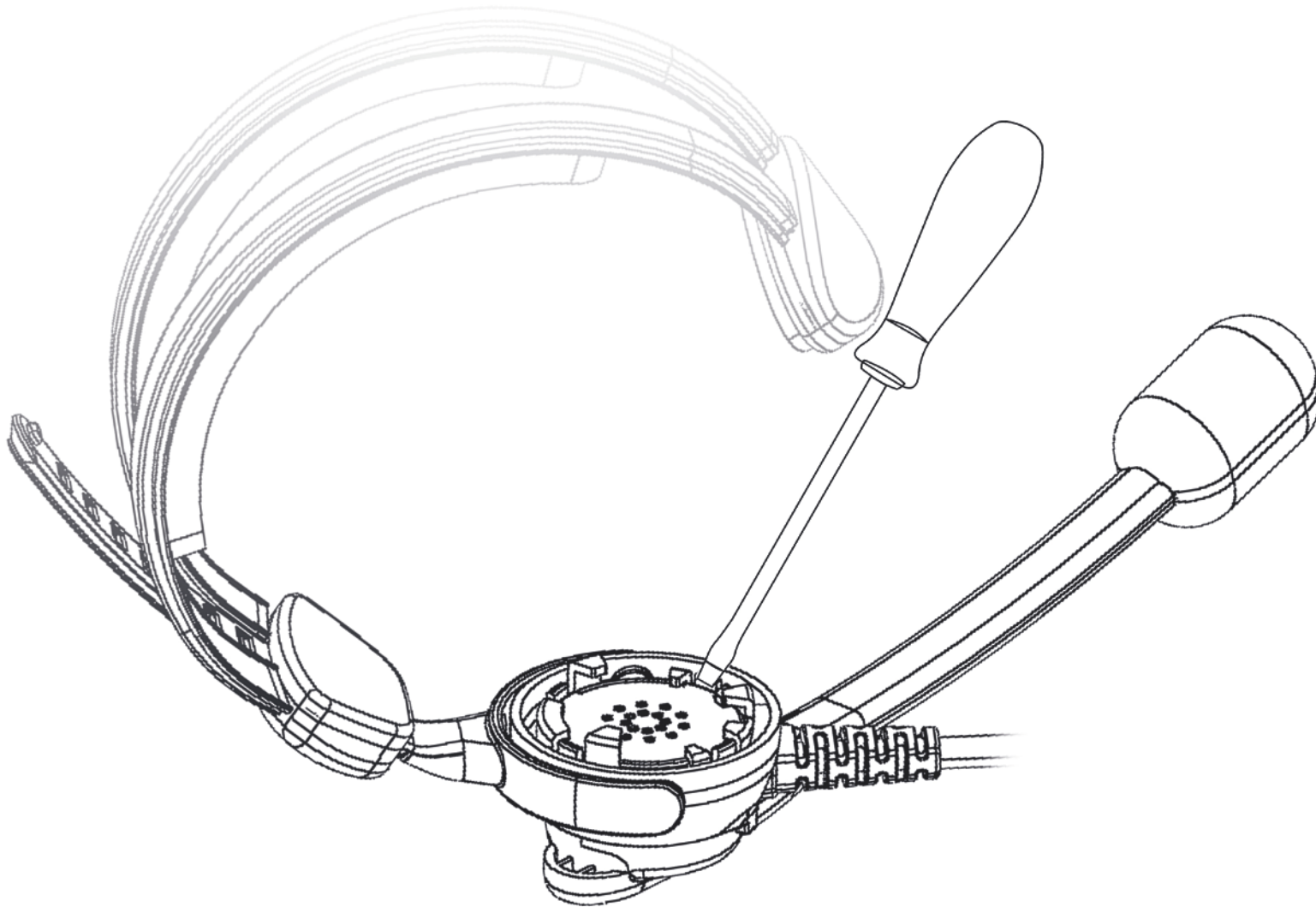
...to take off the mounting disk inclusive the ear-pad





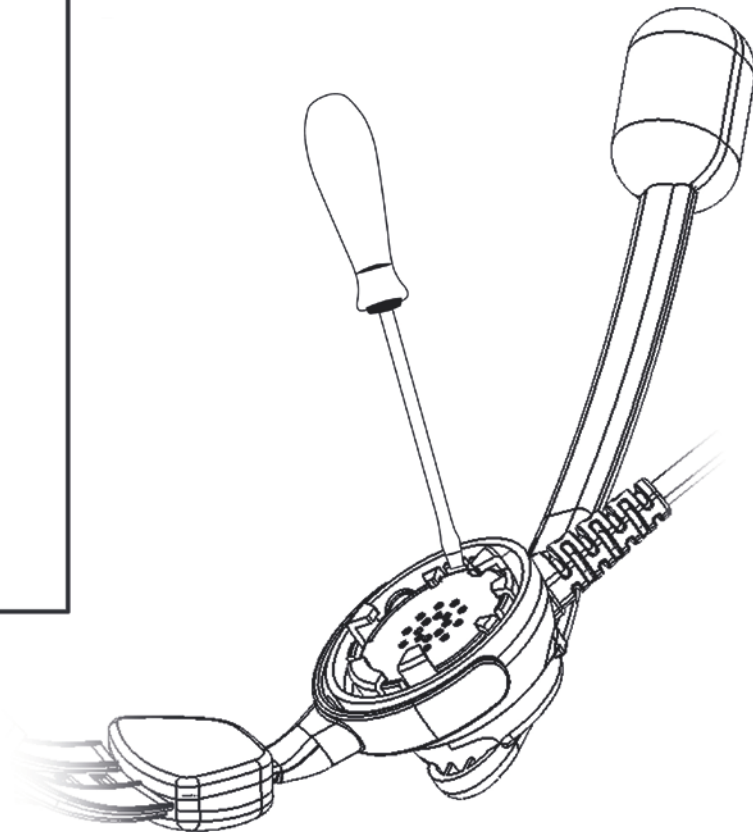
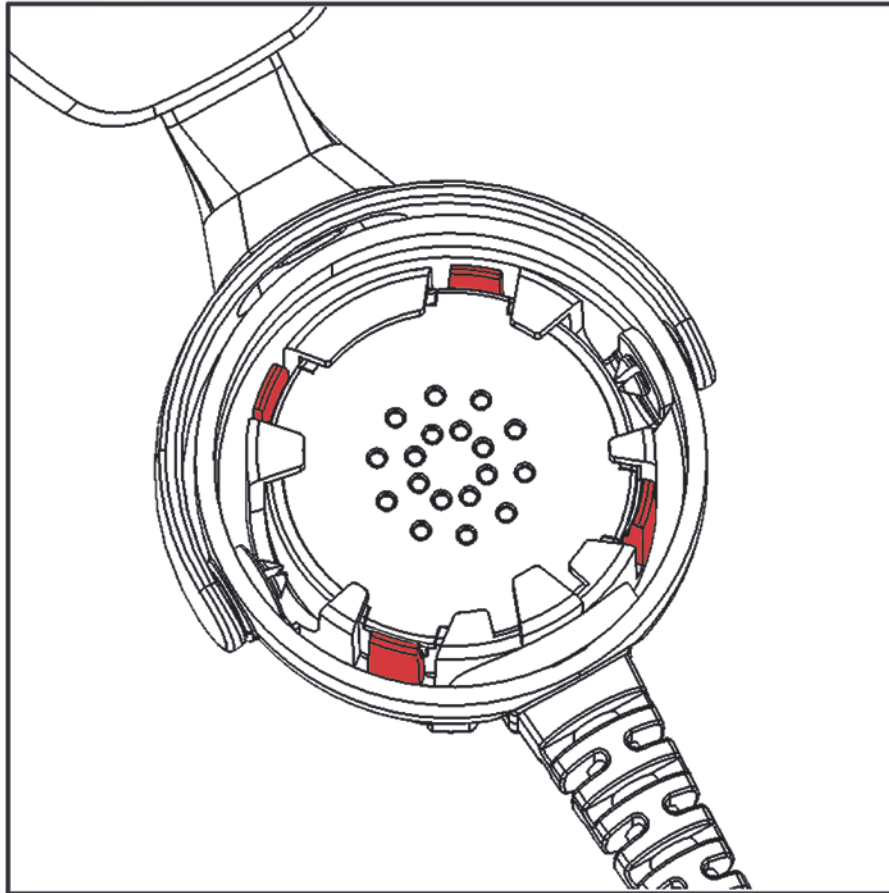
For the next step you will need a screwdriver





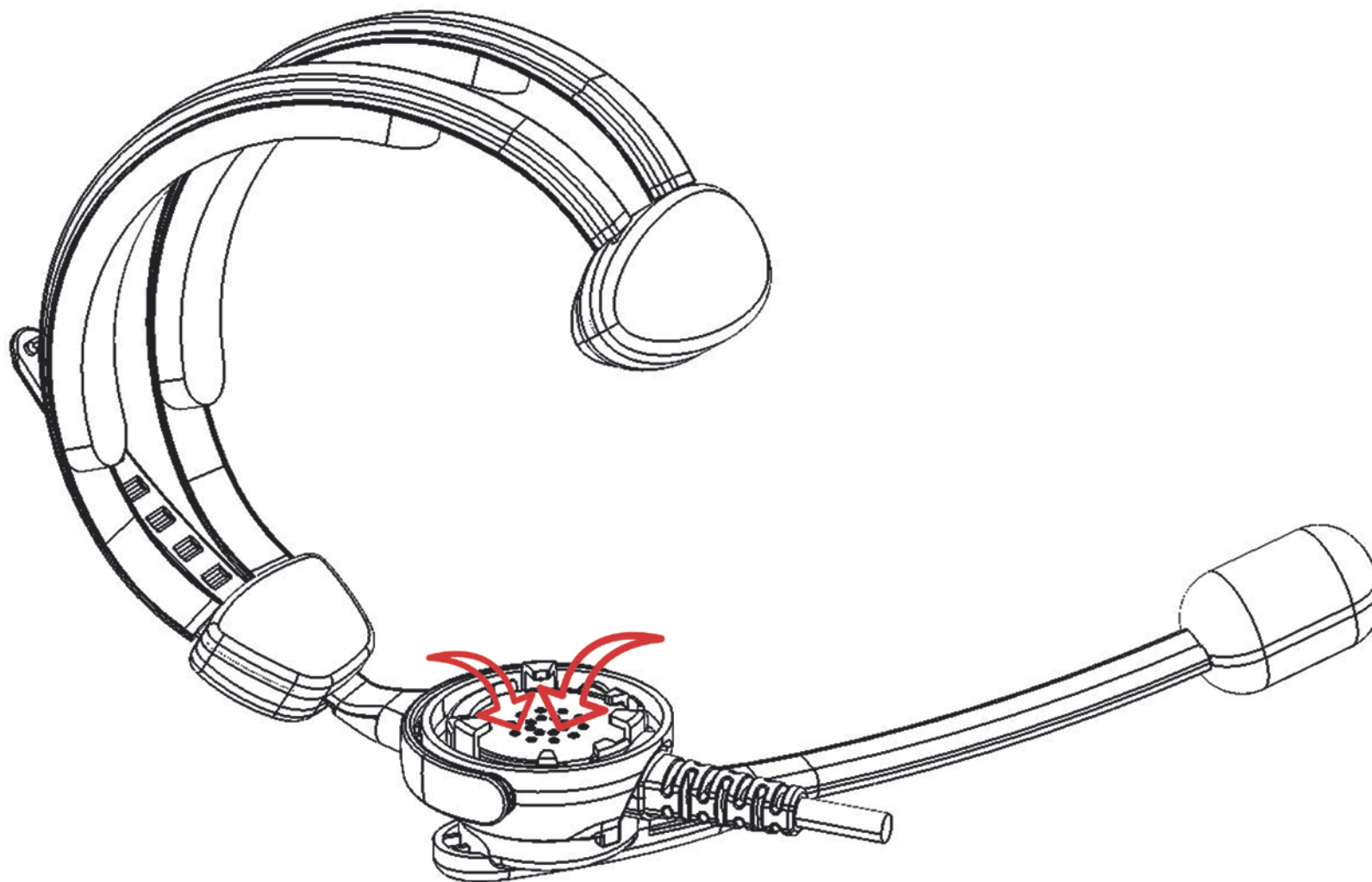
With the help of the screwdriver...

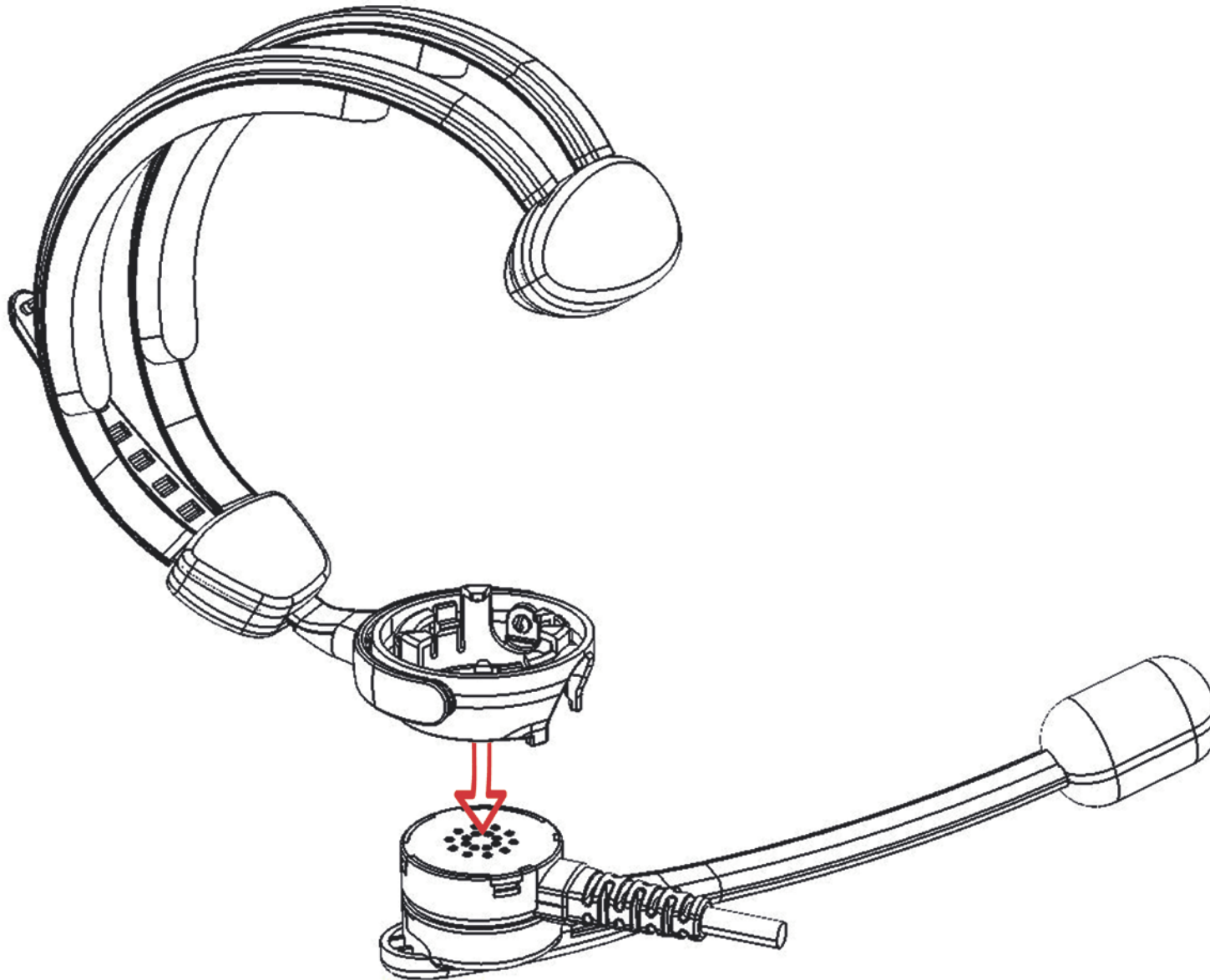




...slightly push four clips to the outside

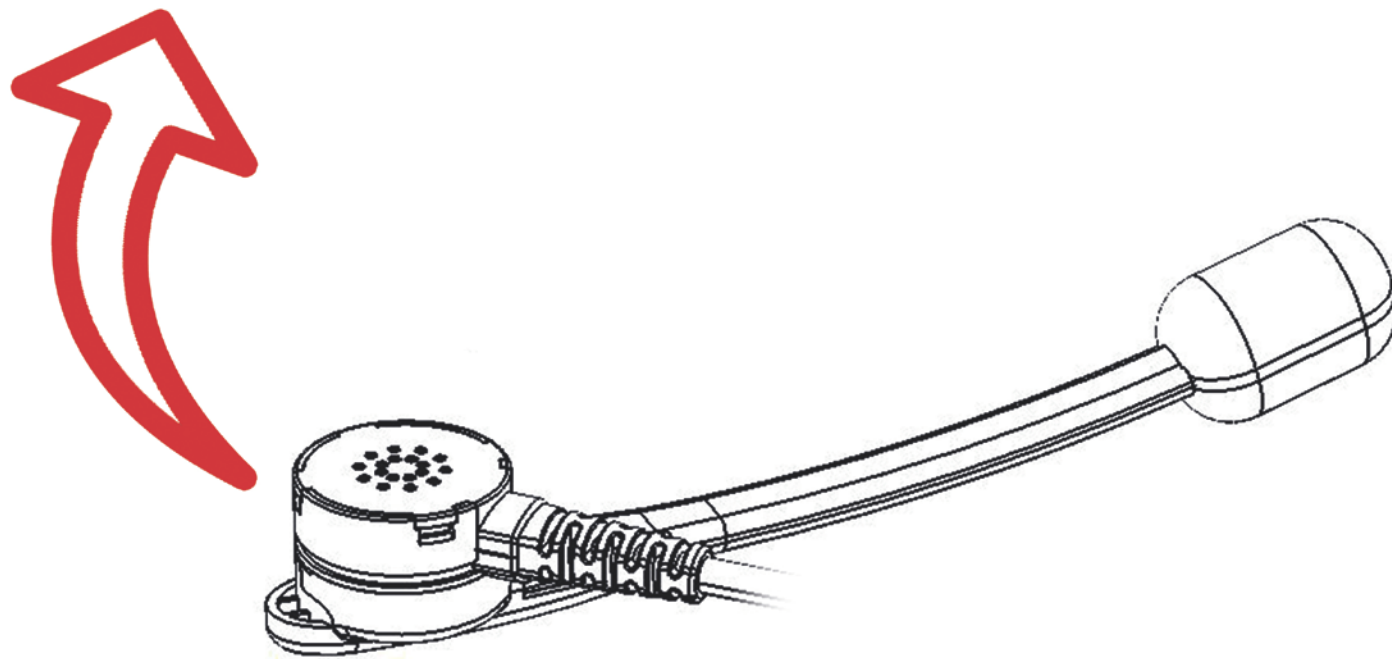






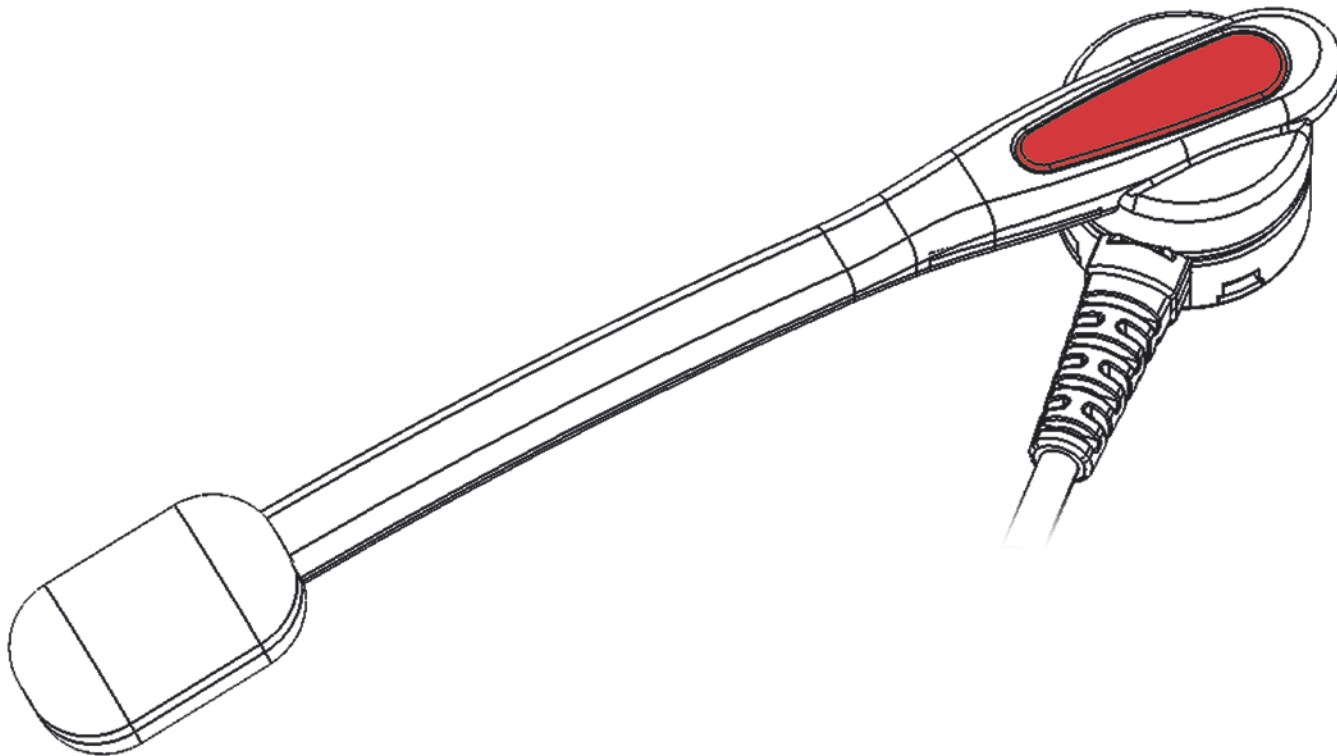
...push down the speaker





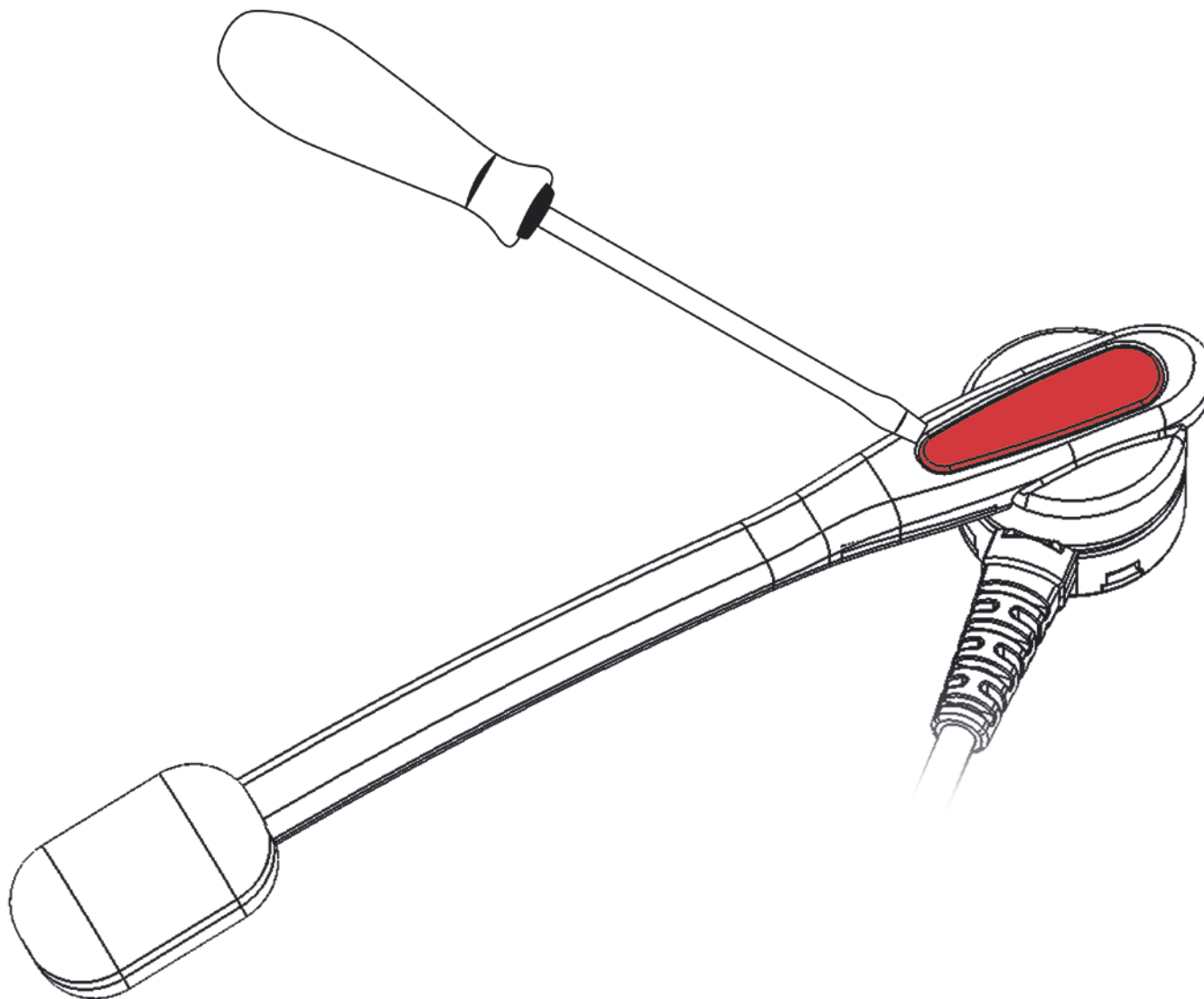
Turn around the speaker





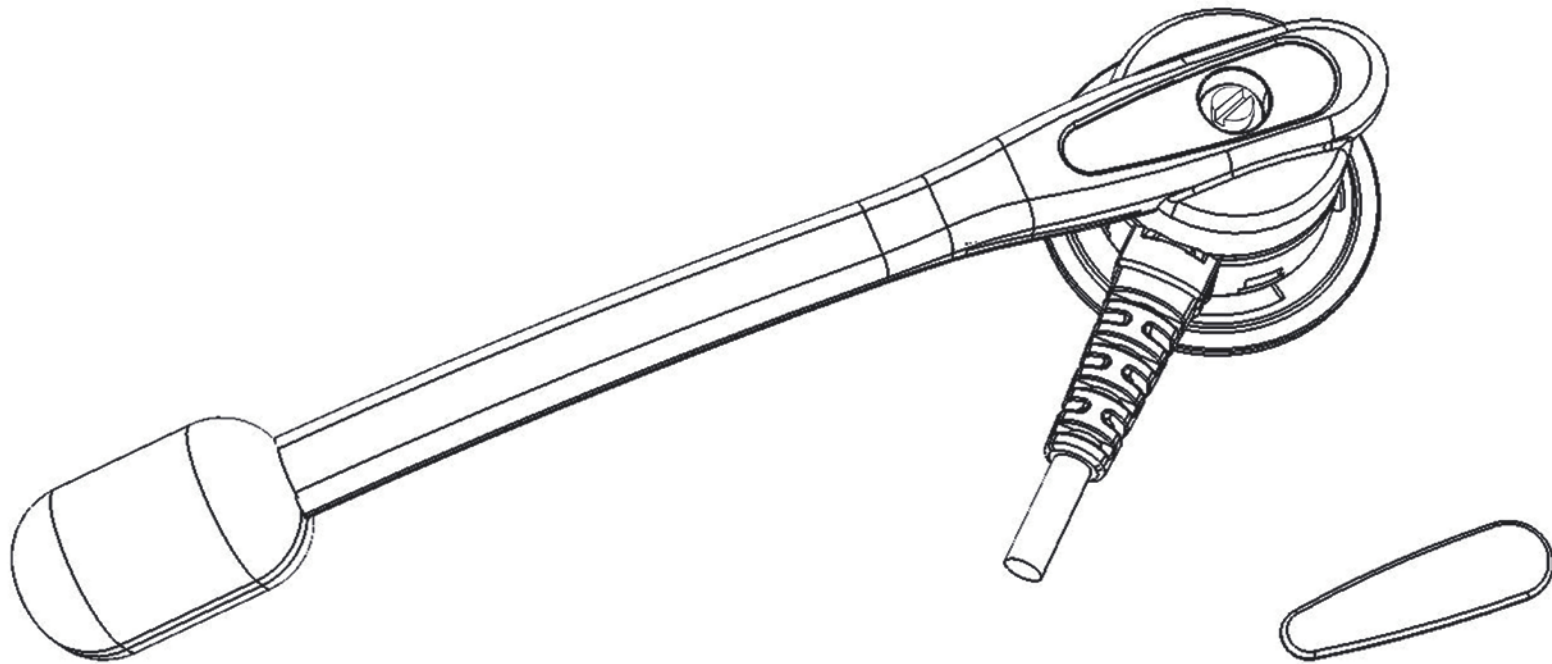
You need to remove the sticker





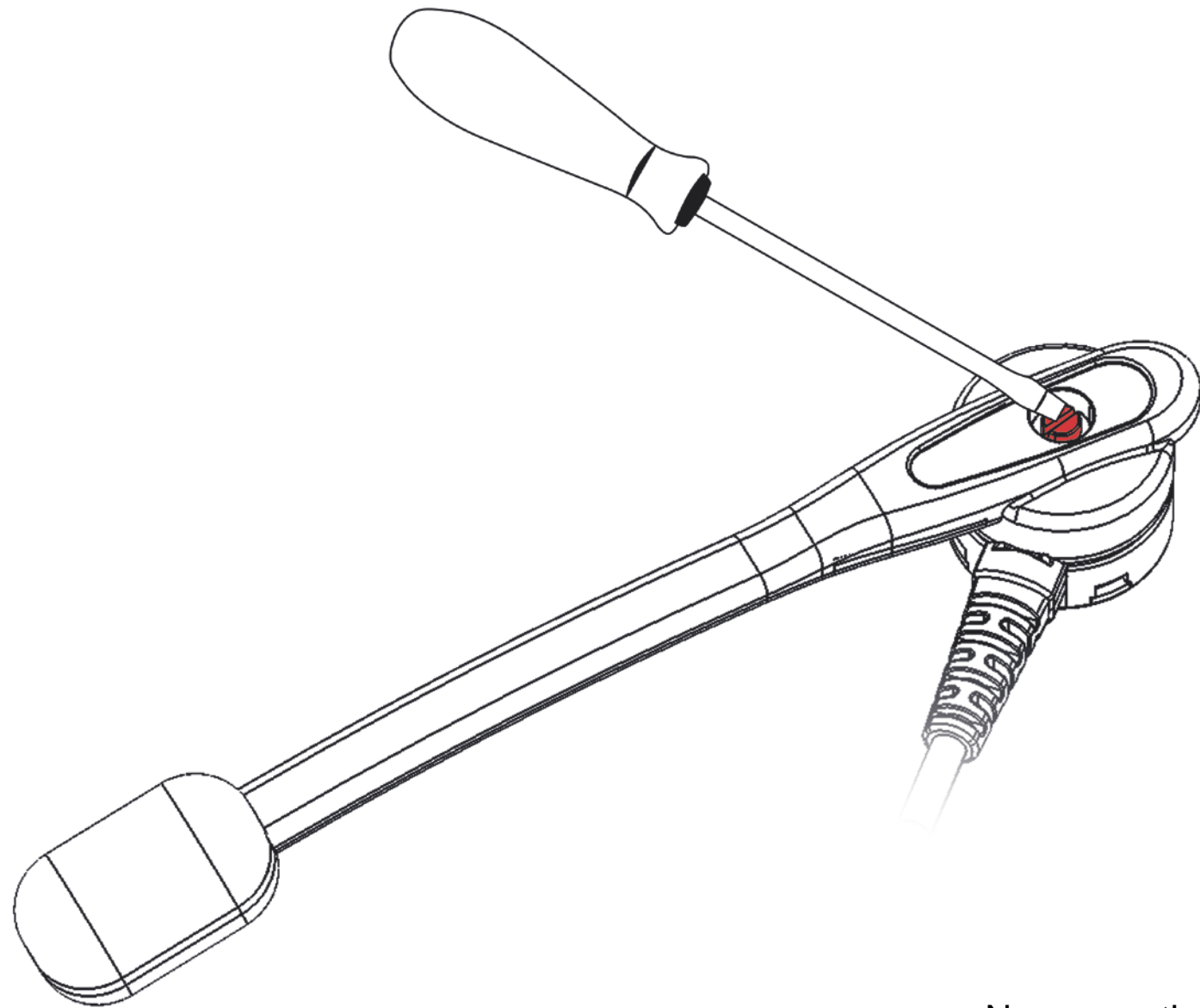
With the help of the screwdriver...





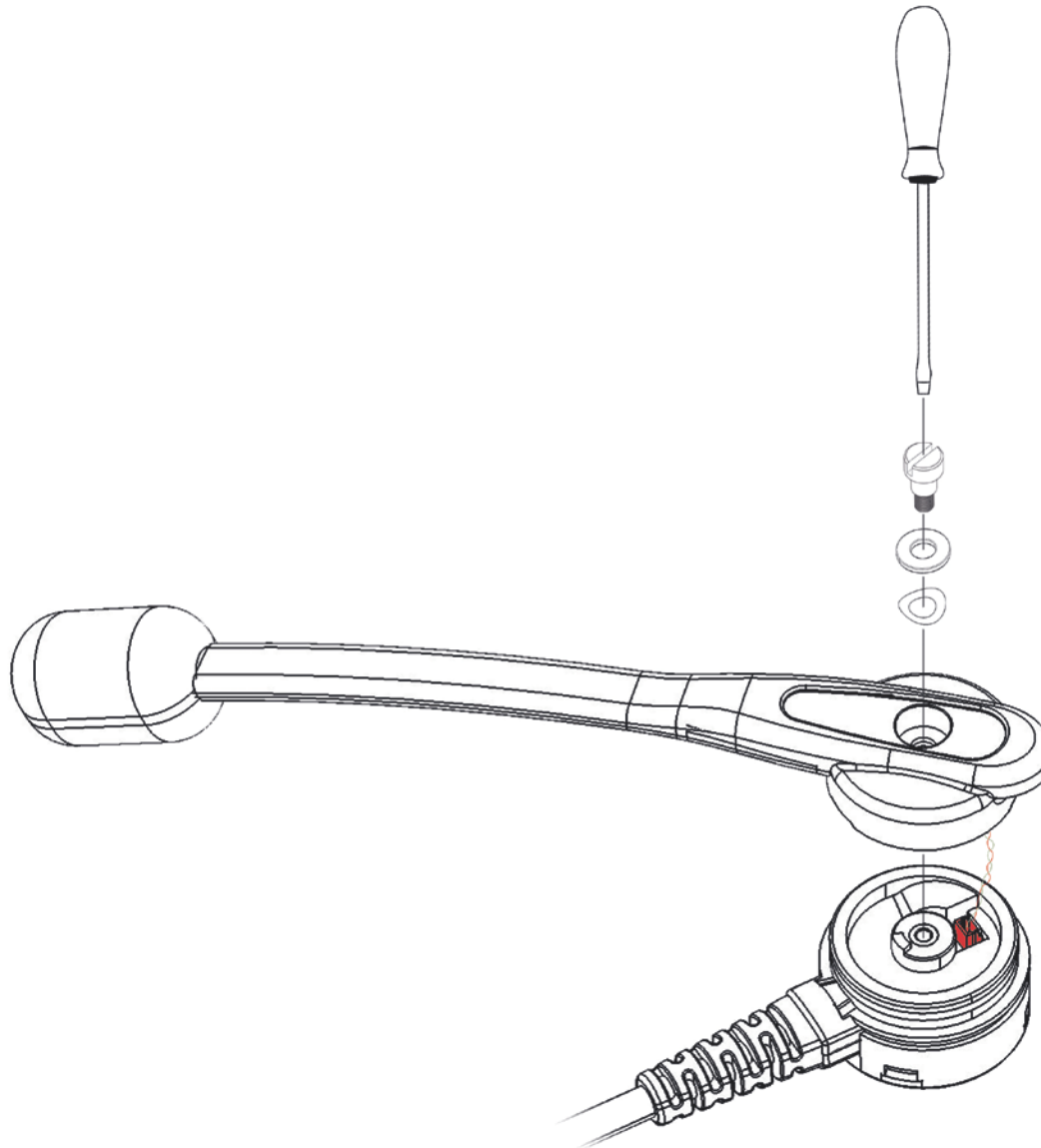
...you remove the sticker





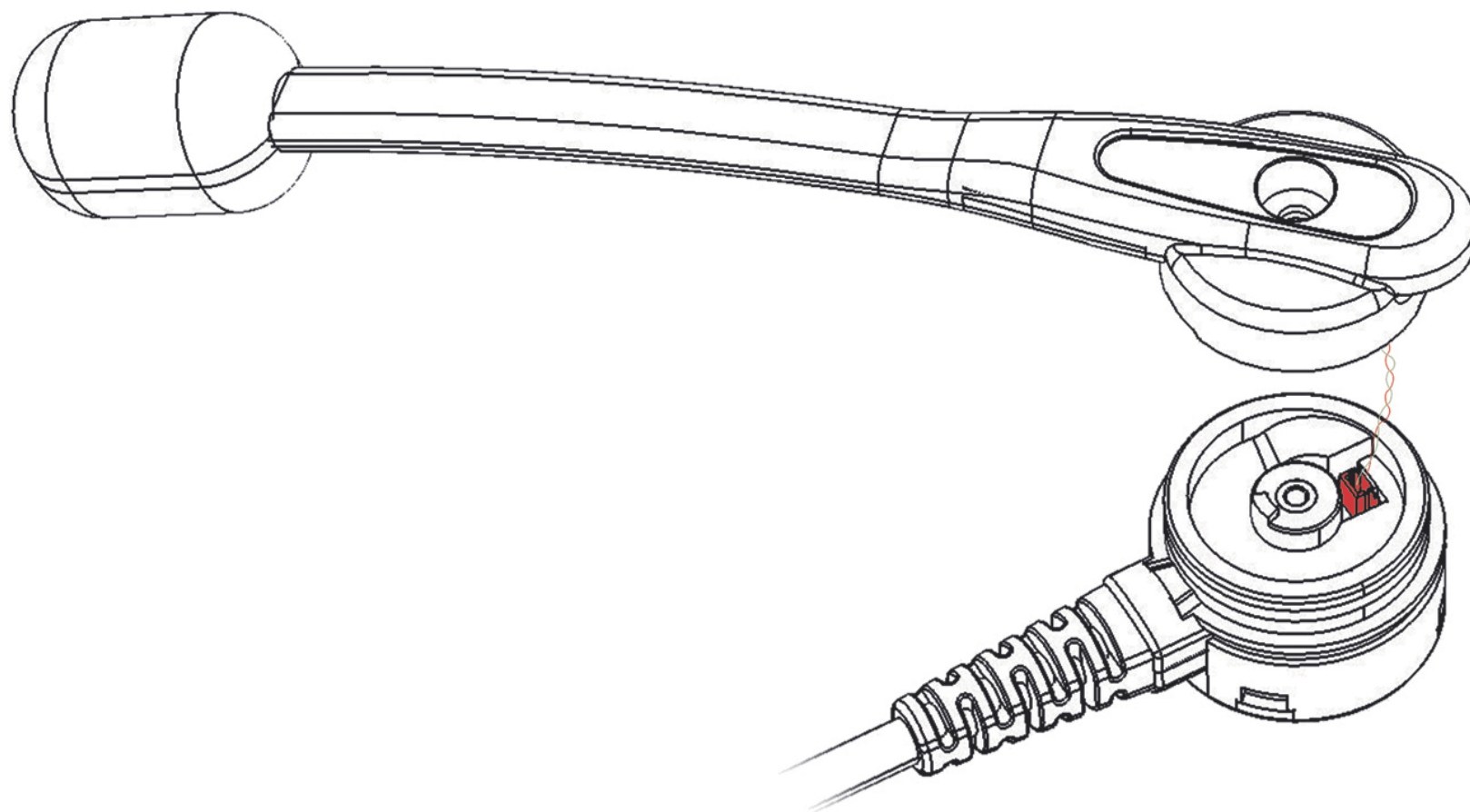
Now open the screw

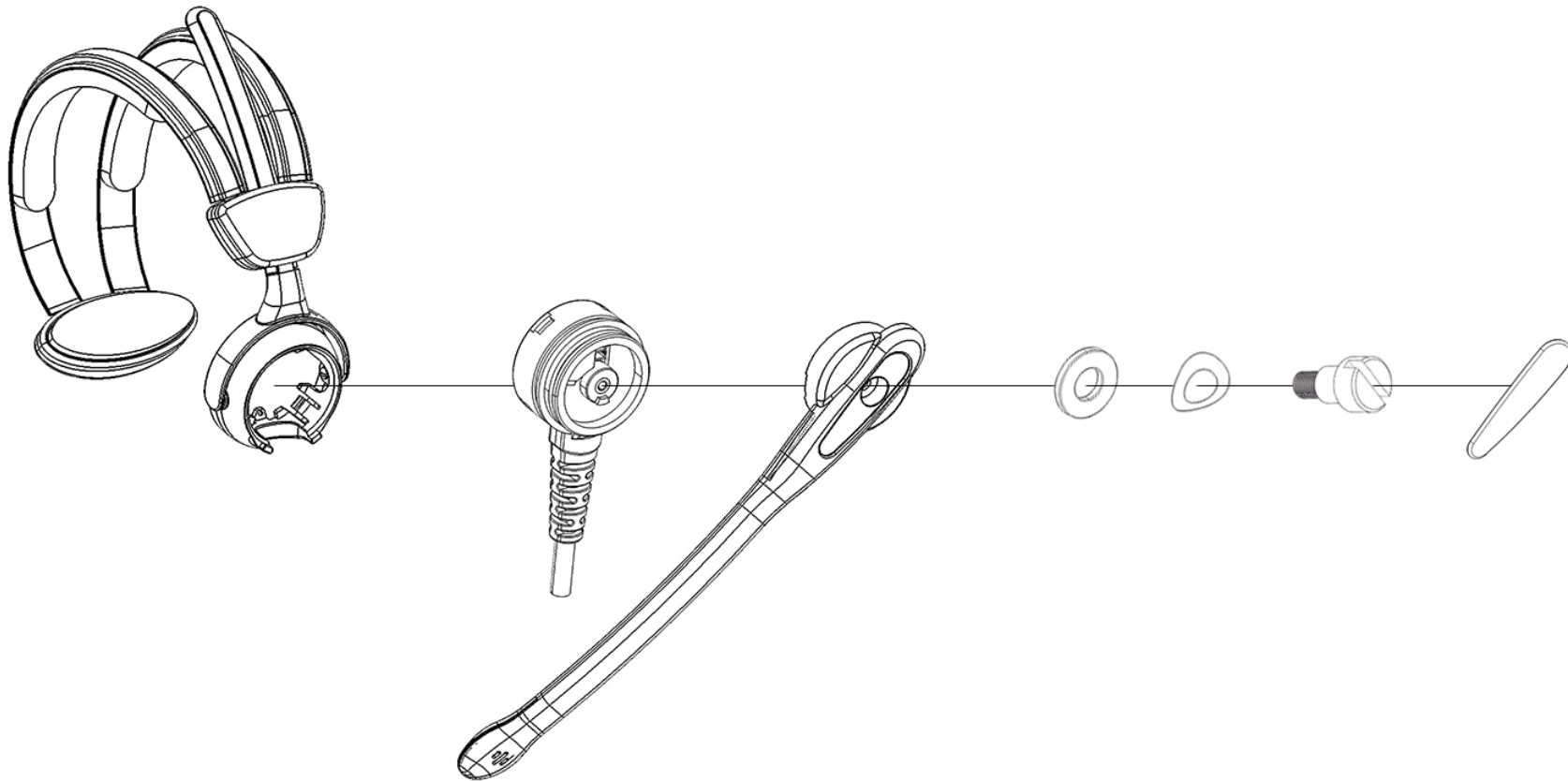




Disassemble slightly the product, be careful and protect the cable

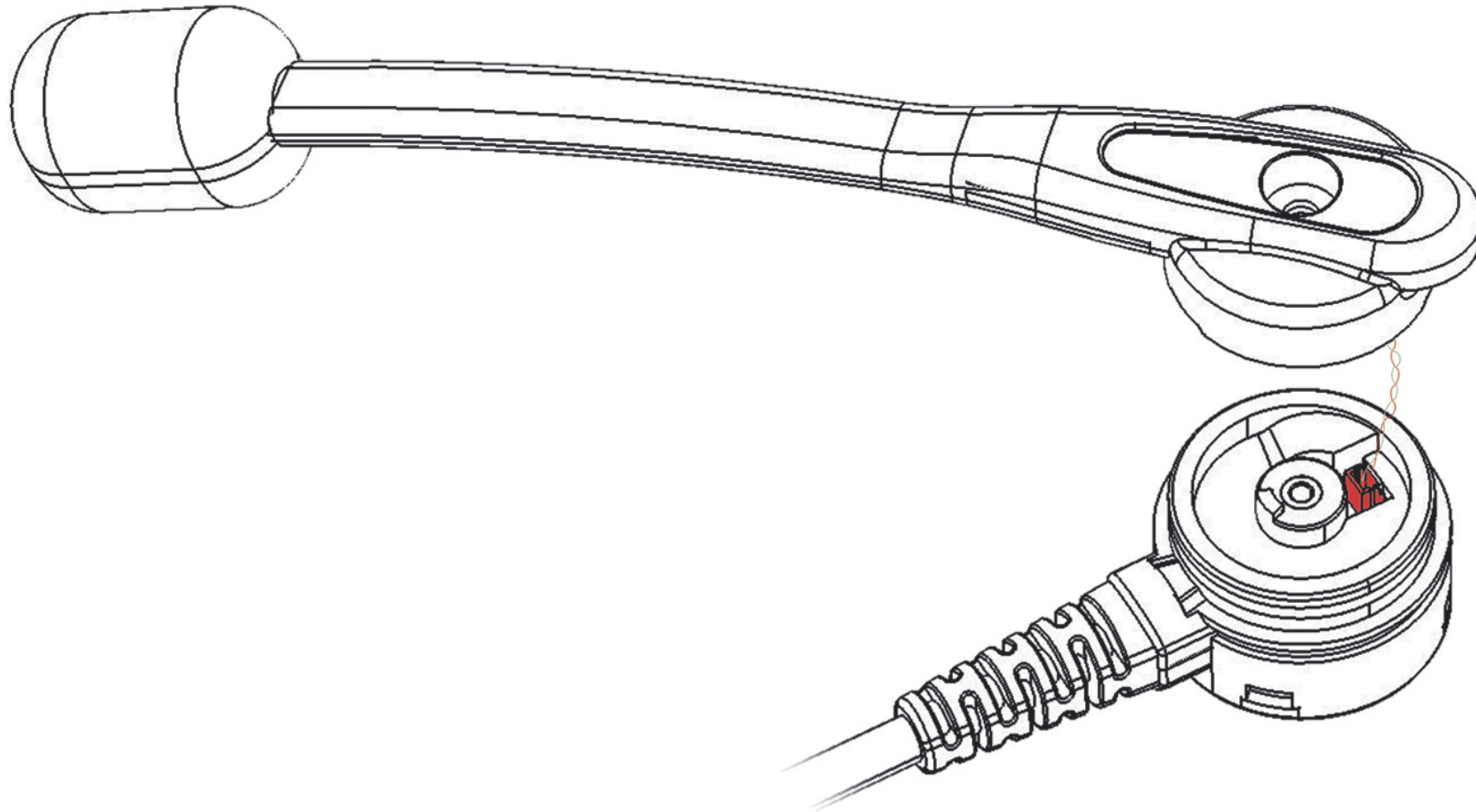






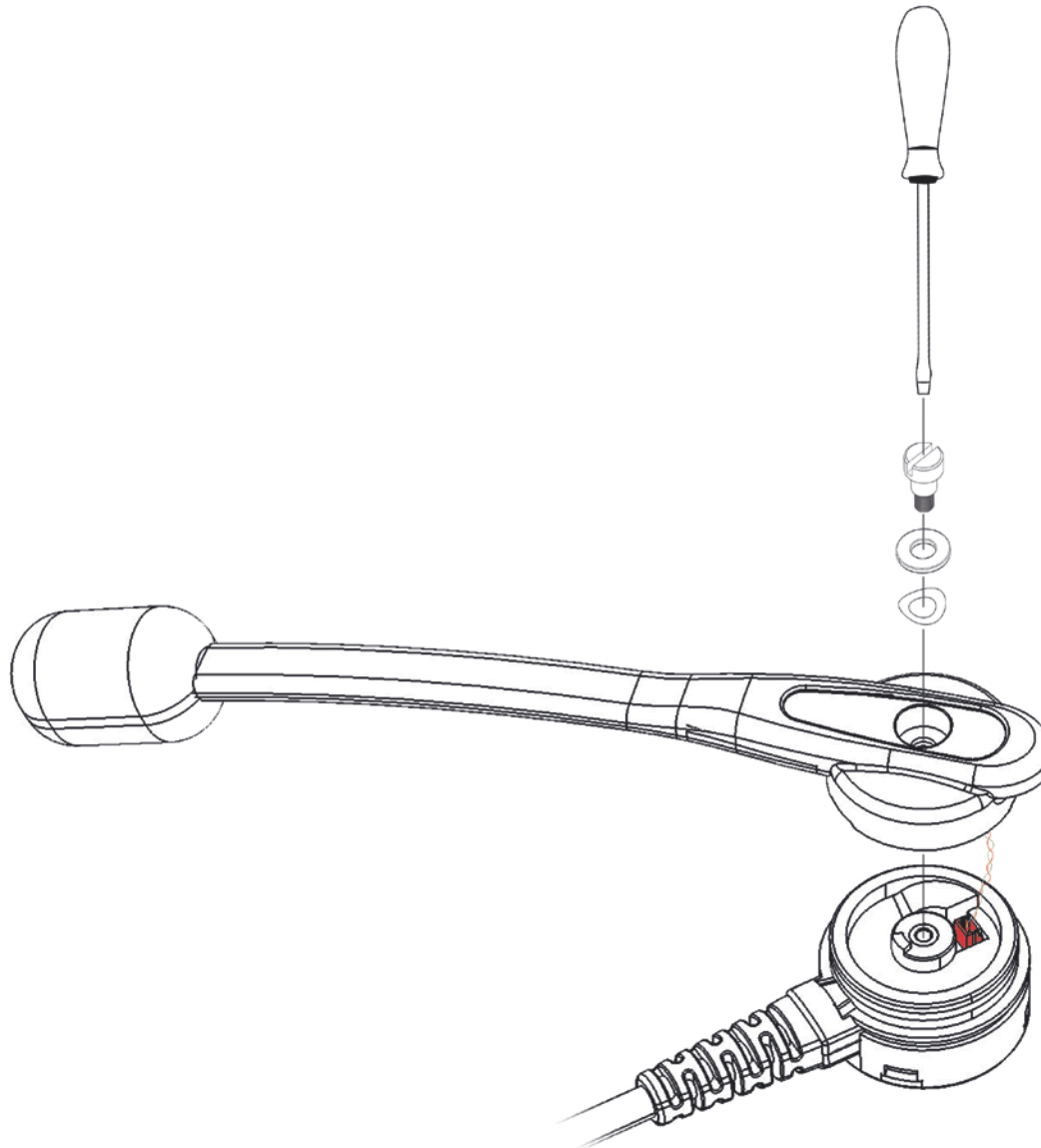
Replace broken parts!

Let's rebuild!



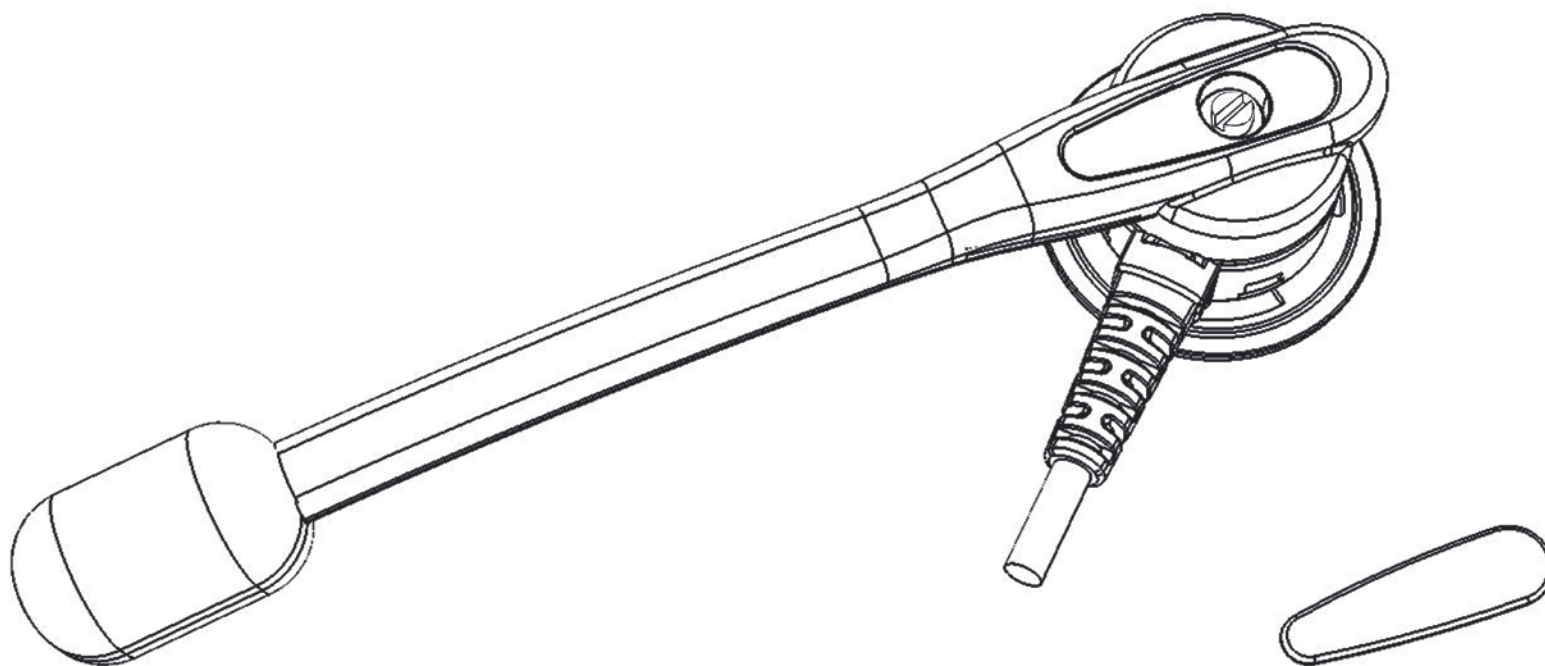
Connect microphone boom and speaker again





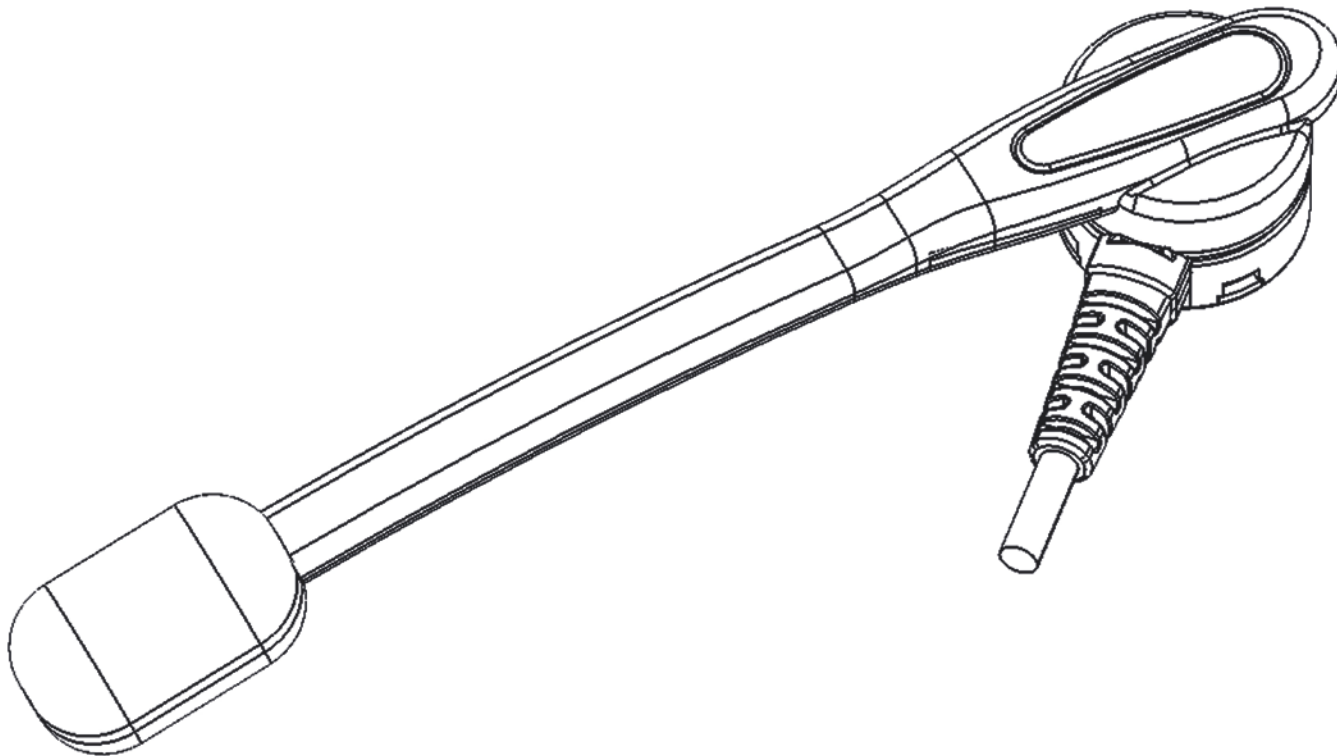
Assemble backwards with the help of the screwdriver





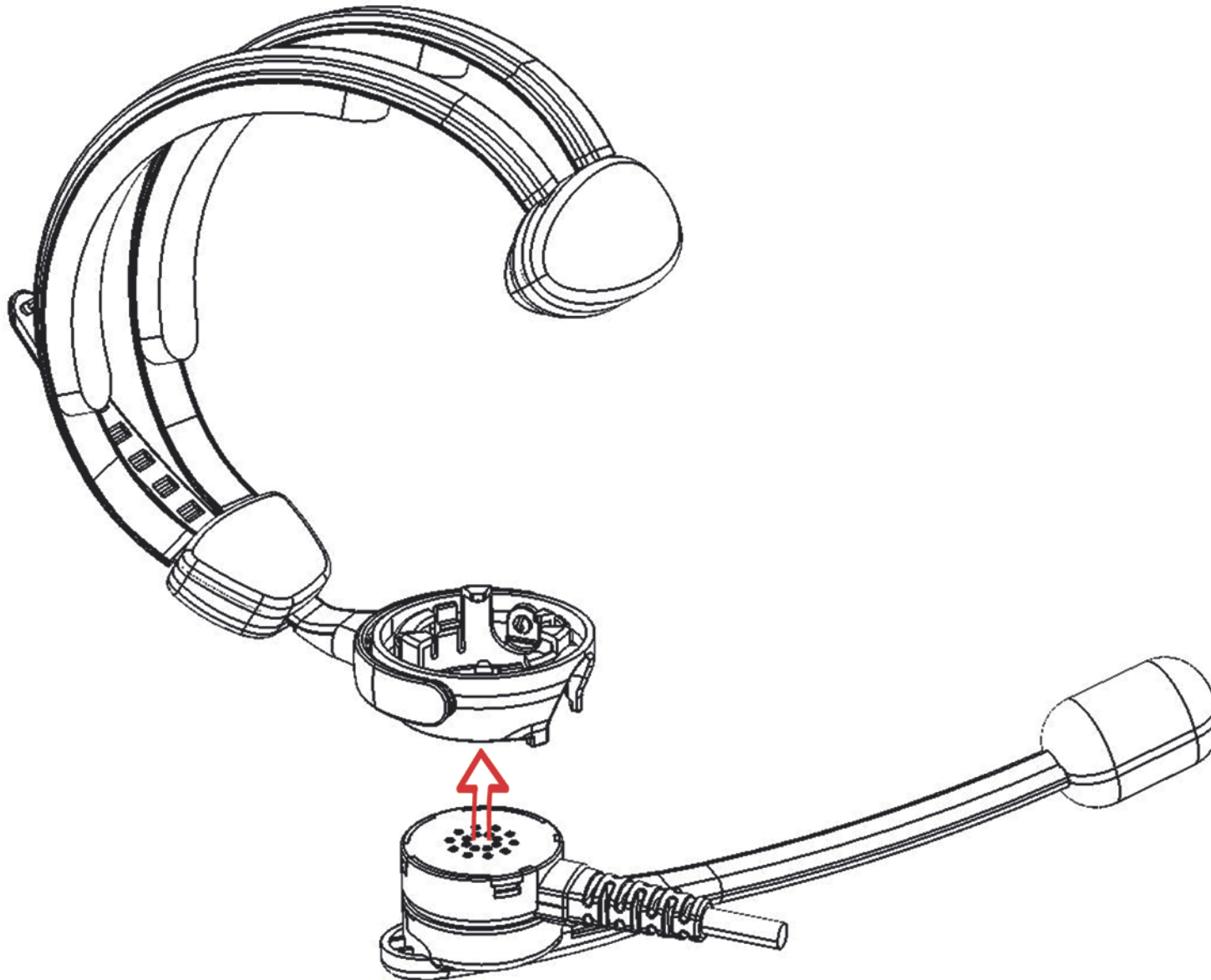
Take the sticker...





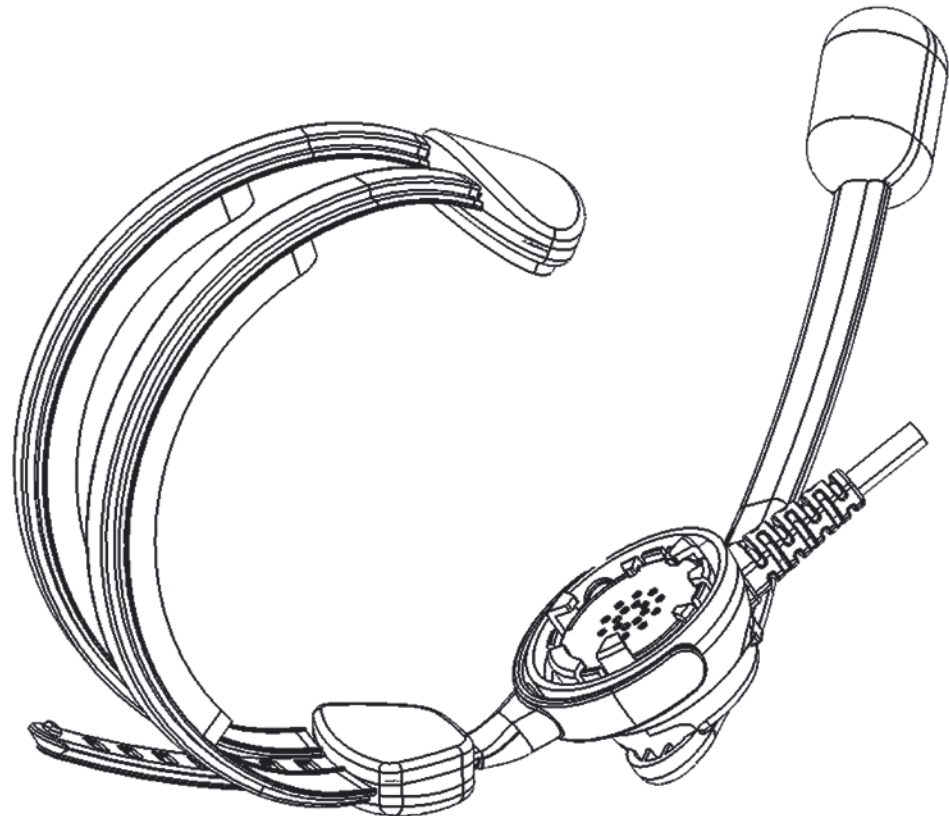
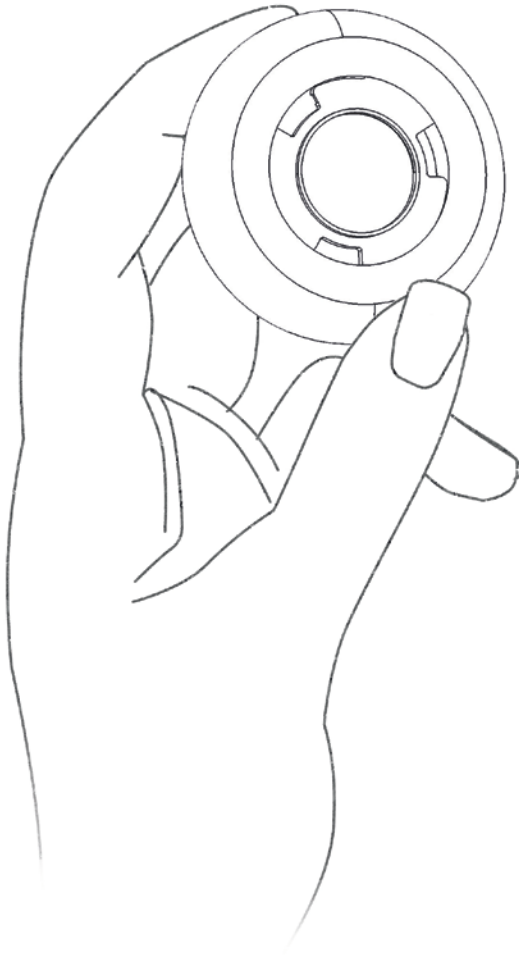
...and put it back to its original position





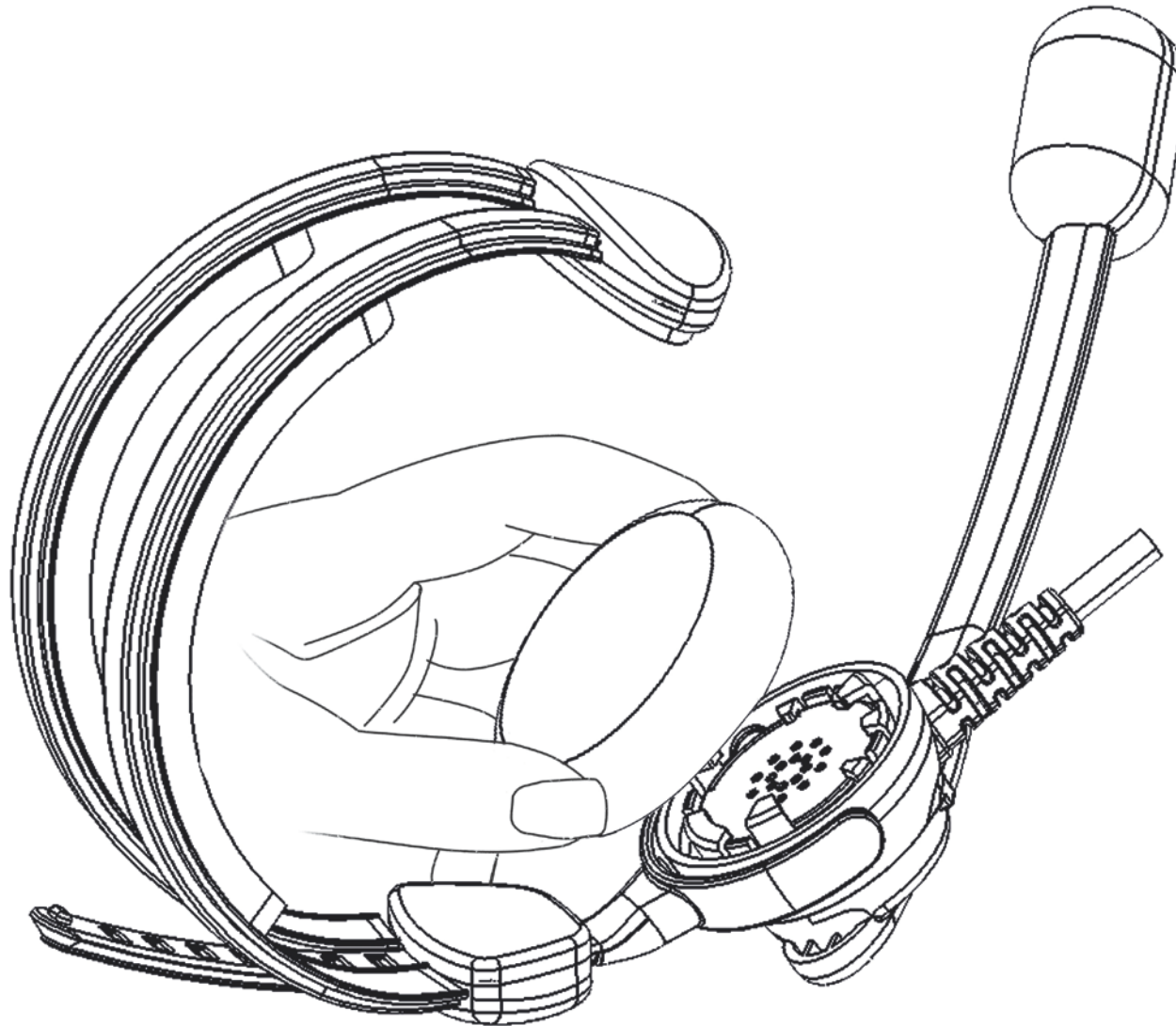
Carefully combine speaker and headband. CLICK!





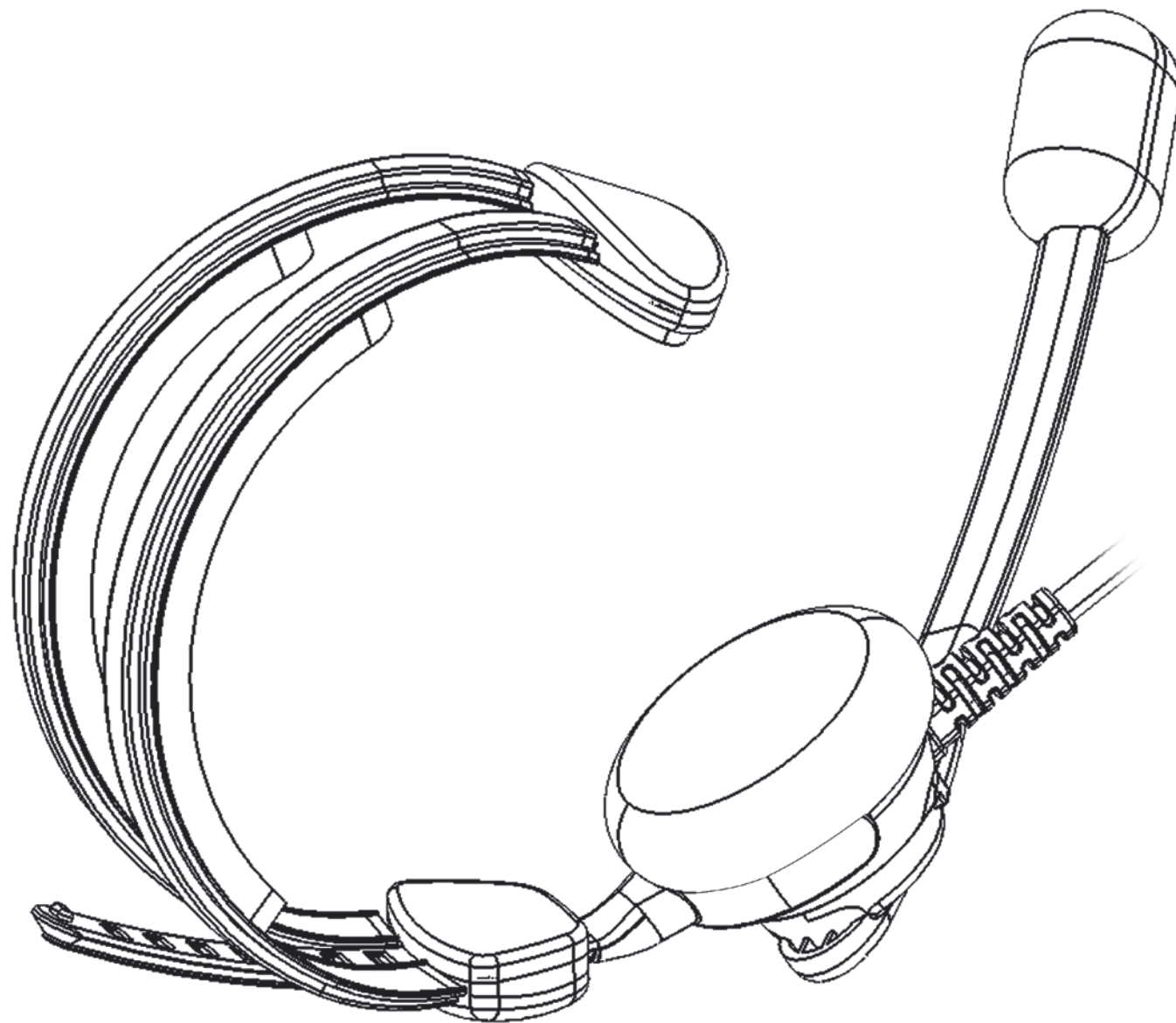
Take the mounting disk with ear-pad



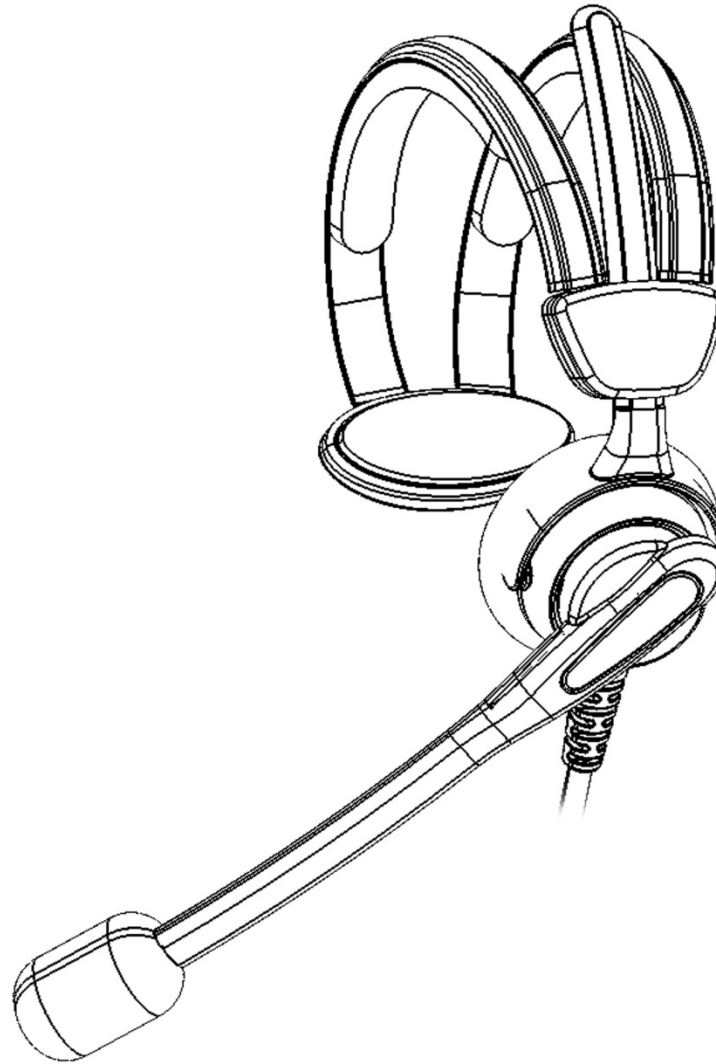


For fixing it on the speaker...
